

**DECLARATION OF STATE OF DISASTER**

WHEREAS the County of Navarro on the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of February, 2022 has or will potentially suffer widespread or severe damage, injury, or loss of life or property (or there is imminent threat of same) resulting from

A severe winter storm with extremely low temperatures, 1/2 " of ice or more and up to 1" of sleet creating hazardous conditions on roads and highways disrupting traffic and transportation routes as well as potential power outages creating dangerous conditions for residents


and;

WHEREAS, the County Judge of Navarro County has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to alleviate the suffering of people and to protect or rehabilitate property;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE COUNTY JUDGE OF NAVARRO COUNTY:

1. That a state of disaster is declared for the County of Navarro.
2. That the County's Emergency Management Plan has been implemented.
3. That this state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than seven days of the date hereof, unless the same is continued by consent of the Commissioners Court of the County of Navarro, Texas.
4. That this proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance.


