

Overview:

In response to recent federal actions, including the White House Executive Order issued on January 28 and the current Continuing Resolution (CR) that extends funding for eligible entities through mid-March, there remains significant uncertainty regarding the continuation of federal grant funding, particularly for the Community Services Block Grant (CSBG). This uncertainty is driven by ongoing discussions within the current Administration and Congress, along with the potential for a government shutdown if the CR isn't extended through September.

To mitigate financial risks and safeguard essential services, Community Services, Inc. (CSI) has taken proactive measures to ensure the agency's stability. This discussion will focus on the immediate actions implemented and the ongoing strategies being pursued to maintain financial and operational continuity.


