The first item on the agenda was the approval of the minutes of the June 15, 2006, Planning and Zoning meeting. Motion to approve by Commissioner Bancroft, second by Commissioner Irvine, all voted aye.

Item #3 on the agenda was consideration of a replat of lot 51 and 52 of Francisco Bay by Frank and Gail Steed. The Steeds own both lots and want to combine them. Motion to approve by Commissioner Irvine, second by Vice Chairman Moe, all voted aye.

Item # 4 on the agenda was consideration of a replat of The Woods at Richland Chambers Phase III by The Woods at Richland Chambers, L.P. The 315' elevation of the lake changed due to extensive dredging by the developers. The replat shows the change in elevation. Motion to approve by Commissioner Martin, second by Commissioner Bancroft, all voted aye with Chairman Jacobson abstaining.

Item # 5 on the agenda was consideration of zoning change #06-06-315 from agriculture to single family 1 for John Putman. This property consists of 49.43 acres in the Samuel Moore Survey and located on SE 2360. Mr. Putman plans to subdivide this property into residential lots. Motion to approve by Commissioner Irvine, second by Commissioner Newton, all voted aye.

Item # 6 on the agenda was consideration of special use permit #06-06-314 for Spence Hummel. This request is for a storage building with a variance for size. The building is 50'x80'. The property is lot 56 of The Shores at Richland Chambers Phase I. Mr. Hummel has an approval letter from The Shores P.O.A. Several commissioners expressed concern that the building was considerably larger than the 10'x12' that the zoning ordinance allows. Mr. Hummel stated there will be no utilities except electricity connected to the building. Motion to approve by Commissioner Martin, second by Commissioner White, all voted aye with the exception of Vice Chairman Moe, and Commissioners Irvine and Bancroft, who voted no.

Item # 7 on the agenda was consideration of zoning change #06-06-316 for Lakeside Methodist Church, David Timmerman, Trustee. This request is from agriculture to single family 1. The property consists of 1 acre in the Julien Fontenoy Survey and located on Azure Lane. Commission members wanted more information regarding access to the property. There was no one present to answer questions. Motion to table by Vice Chairman Moe, second by Commissioner Martin, all voted aye.

Item # 8 on the agenda was consideration of an amendment to the Lakeshore Area Zoning Ordinance regarding the parking of recreational vehicles. This amendment provides definitions and gives the county more authority to deal with abandoned vehicles and illegally stored recreational vehicles. Motion to approve by Commissioner Irvine, second by Commissioner Bancroft, all voted aye.

Item # 9 on the agenda was consideration of an amendment to the Lakeshore Area Zoning Ordinance regarding regulations for airports, heliports and landing strips. Motion to table for further consideration by Commissioner Irvine, second by Commissioner Newton, all voted aye.


