Due to the extreme amount of rainfall that fell in southern portions of Navarro County during the week of April 28th, 2009, Navarro County is currently facing tremendous physical and economic losses. There was extensive damage to numerous roads and bridges in Precincts 2 and 3.

It is estimated that road and bridge damage will exceed \$750,000.00

It is my belief the damage to public works and utility systems due to the rain constitutes a public health and safety hazard. I have determined that this incident is of such severity and magnitude that an effective response is beyond Navarro County's capability to recover without supplementary State and/or Federal assistance. Additionally, I certify that Navarro County does not have local funding available to make the needed repairs and to provide these citizens with effective relief.

Your assistance in this emergency matter, as it affects the safety and health needs of our citizens would be appreciated.

## Navarro County Commissioner's Court Order

WHEREAS, on May 8, 2009, the Navarro County Judge issued a proclamation declaring a State of Disaster for Navarro County resulting from...

Flash flooding in the county due to excessive rainfall;

WHEREAS, the conditions necessitating the Declaration of a State of Disaster continue to exist; and,

WHEREAS, § 418.108(b) of the Texas Government Code provides that a local state of disaster may not be continued for a period in excess of seven (7) days without the consent of the governing body of the political subdivision;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONER'S COURT OF NAVARRO COUNTY:

- That the state of disaster proclaimed for Navarro County by the County Judge on May 8, 2009 shall continue until terminated by order of the Commissioner's Court.
- 2. This ordinance is passed as an emergency measure and pursuant to Navarro County Emergency Management Operations Plan and shall become effective on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2009.
