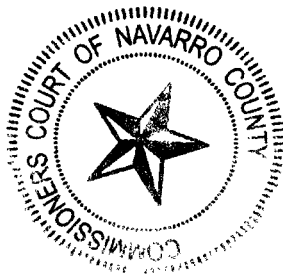

DECLARING A LOCAL STATE OF DISASTER


WHEREAS, the County of Navarro on the 24th day of October, 2010 has suffered widespread or severe damage, injury, or loss of property (or there is imminent threat of same) resulting from a tomado that impacted our community and;

WHEREAS, the judge of the County of Navarro has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to alleviate the suffering of people and to protect or rehabilitate property;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE JUDGE OF THE COUNTY OF NAVARRO:

1. That a state of disaster is declared for the County of Navarro.
2. That the County's Emergency Management Plan has been implemented.
3. That this state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than seven days of the date hereof, unless the same is continued by consent of the Commissioners Court of the County of Navarro, Texas.
4. That this proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance.
