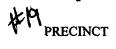

Providing solutions to county problems and issues will allow AgriLife Extension to remain viable to constituents. What could be more important to AgriLife Extension than listening to its "customers" - the people of Texas?

Our ability to meet educational needs depends on knowing what local residents see as their issues that impact their lives. There is no way to know the answers to these questions unless they are asked. Therefore, AgriLife Extension will involve the Leadership Advisory Boards in a process to ask residents what is important to them.

This activity is just one part of the needs assessment process. Other processes to collect information include, but are not limited to:

- State and National Trends
- Commodity/Industry Groups
- State and Federal Mandates
- Emerging Issues
- County Committees/Planning Groups

The issues that surface will be discussed with county committees, task forces, and subject matter specialists to determine the appropriate action for educational programming.

Texas AgriLife Extension is unique because it has faculty in every area of the state who are dedicated to educating Texans in many areas of need. This uniqueness provides an opportunity to bring together the people of Navarro County, other service agencies, and educational groups to help provide solutions to the problems and issues facing residents of Navarro County.

Overview of the Process

The process of identifying relevant issues is fundamental to the program development model for Extension. The uniqueness that Extension offers is the involvement of local clientele in charting the course of the educational programs that Extension will offer. The involvement of a representative group of local leaders in identifying and prioritizing the critical issues that a community is facing is paramount to maintaining the relevance of our programs. While long-term strategic visioning is a core responsibility of the Leadership Advisory Board, there is also a need to involve others in identifying issues relevant to the county. The Leadership Advisory Board will remain the catalyst in this process.

A group of local leaders will be identified and involved in a process to identify and prioritize issues for the Navarro County Extension program to address through educational programming. This process will involve a diverse and representative group of individuals, but will be focused on the core areas that Extension has a history of addressing, and is equipped to continue to address.

4-H and Youth Development:

Navarro County 4-H members participated in four Major Stock Shows from January through March. Thirty nine members exhibited various projects ranging from market lambs, market goats, market barrow, market steers, and breeding beef heifers. The Houston Livestock Show and Rodeo was very rewarding to our 4-H'ers this year; winning Grand Champion Angus Scramble Heifer, and another youth catching at the calf scramble during a rodeo performance.

This spring Navarro County 4-H had 582 entries for the Navarro County Youth Expo. This accounts for 50.7% of the participating youth at the county show making Navarro County 4-H the largest organization to participate.

The spring is also the time for many of our 4-H county and district contests. Navarro County 4-H had 13 members compete in the Consumer Decision Making Contest with all participates advancing to the district contest. At the District 8 Roundup, 6 4-H members participated in Method Demonstrations and Educational Presentations with one advancing to the Texas 4-H Roundup in the Share the Fun Contest in the Vocal Category. Seventeen youth participated in the Second Annual Animal Science 101 Workshop and 4 youth participated in the Livestock Judging Workshop. Twelve 4-H members entered the Recordbook contest with one youth advancing to state. Six youth attended the District 8 Leadership Lab Camp held in Brownwood at the Texas 4-H Conference Center. Five senior 4-H members lead workshops and 6 junior 4-H members attended the Southeast District 8 Multi-County Camp in Palestine.

Agriculture/Natural Resources:

Field Crop Production and Management—

This outcome program targeted 40 producers who rely on field crop production. Programs included a crop update seminar, the Blackland Income Growth Conference, Cotton Stalk Destruction and Blackland Grain Producers Association meeting's along with the Navarro/Hill Wheat Field Day. Thirty two of forty participants completed retrospective post surveys indicating increases in knowledge along with intent to adopt best practices.

Forage Production for Hay and Grazing

Forage production and management was identified as a key issue by program area committees. A Pesticide Applicator training was held on January 20 with 12 individuals completing the training and 100% successfully completing the exam with an average score of 85.5%.

Beef Cattle Production and Economics

Beef cattle production in Navarro County is a critical component of the local economy accounting for \$21.1 million in annual gross sales. At the beginning of 2011, 1400 beef management calendars were printed and mailed or delivered to 987 producers. In addition, a cattle production workshop was held in February with 55 people attending representing 12.423 acres and 1753 cows. Estimated economic impact by 12 producers was \$32.08 per cow, per year savings/earnings and \$56,242 in total estimated economic impact.

Natural Resource Management

There is a substantial interest from county landowners in wildlife, water, and plant management. Concerns about wildfire danger have also emerged which resulted in a fire weather forecast conference call in January followed by an introduction to Prescribed Burning Workshop. Of the 108 people in attendance, 87 completed a survey representing 95,492 total unique acres owned or managed. There are 15,752 total unique acres that are desired to be burned in the next 2 years with 53 reporting an average size of 322 acres. There were 75.7% (53 of 70) expressing a desire to conduct burns in the next 2 years along with 11 participants stating they wanted to participate in a certified prescribed burn manager training.

Family and Consumer Sciences:

Healthy Lifestyles -

Walk Across Texas:

The Walk Across Texas! 8 week program was designed to help establish the habit of regular physical activity. During the spring of 2011, 412 individuals plus 3 school teams of 51 youth registered to participate in the program. A kick off and ending event were held with weekly news updates distributed via email, Facebook, and Twitter. There were 230 individuals completing the 8 week program logging a total of 56,029 miles. Including health care cost savings and cost of lost wages, the total potential economic impact for the 2011 Navarro County team participants is approximately \$3,058,519. Community partners included VOICE, Inc. and Navarro Regional Hospital.

Healthy County:

Weight Watchers at Work was implemented in February as part of the Texas Association of Counties Healthy County Initiative. There were 20 individuals completing the first 17 week series losing a total of 359 pounds. Due to the program's success, a second series began in June with 25 participants.

Balancing Food and Play:

The Balancing Food & Play curriculum was designed for 3rd grade students to improve knowledge and behaviors related to snacking on fruits and vegetables, drinking milk with meals and water with snacks, encouraging 60 minutes of physical activity, and limiting screen time to two hours or less per day. This 20 lesson series was implemented with 3rd graders at Bowie Elementary and JL Collins Catholic School during the spring of 2011. From the 60 pre/post surveys administered, student knowledge gains were noted for 4 of 4 knowledge questions. The percentage of students who reported having 60 minutes or more of physical activity increased from 42% (22) to 53% (32). The percentage of students who reported having excessive screen time (4 hours or more) decreased from 21% (11) to 13% (8). The percentage of students who reported always or almost always drinking regular (non-diet) soda decreased from 21% (11) to 16% (10).

Health Literacy: Adults with limited health literacy skills are more likely to report their health as poor and are more likely to lack health insurance, less likely to use preventive services and control chronic conditions, and more likely to misunderstand instructions about prescription medication, medication errors and mortality. To address this issue, a 4 week Health Literacy series was held for Seniors in Goodlow at the Mt. B Zion Baptist church. Post survey results indicate that 100% (17) of the participants understand that half of their health status may be determined by lifestyle choices, 93% better understand their Medicare benefits for preventive services and 100% understanding how to talk with their doctor and how to manage their medications better.

Diabetes Education: There were 8 individuals completing the first 2011 Do Well, Be Well with Diabetes class series. A second series along with Cooking Well with Diabetes and a Diabetes one day conference will be held in the fall.

Thanks for allowing me the opportunity to update you on the Extension educational programming in Navarro County and the efforts being made by your county Extension agents, Paula and Emily. 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GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

Certification of such coverage must be provided to the County upon commencement of this work.

INVOICES & PAYMENTS: Contractor shall submit an original invoice on each purchase order or purchase release after each delivery, indicating the purchase order number. Invoices must be itemized. Any invoice which cannot be verified by the contract price and/or is otherwise incorrect will be returned to the Contractor for correction. Under term contracts, when multiple deliveries and/or services are required, the Contractor may invoice following each delivery and the County will pay on invoice. Prior to any and all payments made for goods and/or services provided under this contract, the Contractor should provide his Taxpayer Identification Number or social security number as applicable. information must be on file with the Navarro County Auditor's Office. Failure to provide this information may result in a delay in payments and/or back-up withholding as required by the Internal Revenue Service.

PRICING: Prices for all goods and/or services shall be negotiated to a firm amount for the duration of this contract or as agreed to in terms of time frame. All prices must be written in ink or typewritten. Where unit pricing and extended pricing differ, unit pricing prevails. Pricing is attached and agreed upon as Exhibit 1 attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

SEVERABILITY: If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase or word of these requirements or the specifications shall be held invalid, such holding shall not affect the remaining portions of these requirements and the specifications and it is hereby declared that such remaining portions would have been included in these requirements and the specifications as though the invalid portion had been omitted.

SILENCE OF SPECIFICATIONS: The apparent silence of specifications as to any detail, or the apparent omission from it of a detailed description concerning any point, shall be regarded as meaning that only the best commercial practice is to prevail and that only material and workmanship of the finest quality are to be used. All interpretations of specifications shall be made on the basis of this statement. The items furnished under this contract shall be new, unused of the latest product in production to commercial trade and shall be of the highest quality as to materials used and workmanship. furnishing these items shall be experienced in design and construction of such items and shall be an established supplier of the item.
