NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE JUDGE OF THE COUNTY OF NAVARRO:

- 1. That a state of disaster is declared for the County of Navarro.
- 2. That the County's Emergency Management Plan has been implemented.
- 3. That this state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than seven days of the date hereof, unless the same is continued by consent of the Commissioners Court of the County of Navarro, Texas.
- 4. That this proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance.
