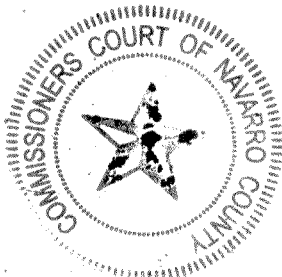

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

THATWE Silver Tusk Operating Company, LLC - 19500 State Highway 249, Suite 270 - Houston, TX 77070 as Principal, and ATLANTIC SPECIALTY INSURANCE COMPANY, a corporation duly incorporated under the laws of the State of New York and authorized to do business in the State of New York, as Surety, are held and firmly bound unto Navarro County Precinct 2 - 907 NW 2nd Street - Kerens, TX 75144, as Obligee, in the penal sum of Two Hundred Forty Thousand & 00/100 (\$240,000.00) Dollars, for the payment of which we hereby bind ourselves, our heirs, executors and administrators, jointly and severally, firmly by these presents.

This bond shall become effective on September 18, 2014

PROVIDED, that regardless of the number of years this bond is in force, the Surety shall not be liable hereunder for a larger amount, in the aggregate, than the penal sum listed above.

PROVIDED FURTHER, that the Surety may terminate its liability hereunder as to future acts of the Principal at any time by giving thirty (30) days written notice of such termination to the Obligee.

Power of Attorney

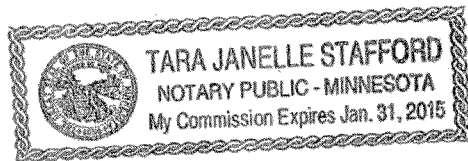
