This multiplication of ministry is, in the tradition of pastoral leadership, one of the most significant measures of a pastor's impact: not the size of the congregation he built, but the number of servants he sent out. In 1995, the Texas House of Representatives passed a resolution honoring Reverend Dairy G. Johnson, Sr. on the occasion of his tenth anniversary as pastor of Bethlehem Missionary Baptist Church. The resolution — signed by the legislature of the 74th Texas Legislature — cited his service to the church, his leadership in the Interdenominational Ministerial Alliance of Navarro County, his role in various denominational conventions, and his broader community service. It noted that in Reverend Johnson, the congregation had found both a preacher and a stalwart friend for the work of the ministry. That legislative recognition was meaningful, but those who knew Dairy Johnson understood that the honor most alive to him was not the one written on official paper. It was the one that came week after week, in the faces of the people who gathered in the church he served — people who had trusted him with their souls, their sorrows, and their

celebrations, and who had not been let down. As of this writing, Dairy Gene Johnson, Sr. has served as senior pastor of Bethlehem Missionary Baptist Church. Pastor Johnson faithfully serves various religious and civic organizations.
